Local Projects:

- Our club provides a dictionary to each 3rd grader in Wayne County each fall including public, private, and home schools
- We provide multiple \$1,000 college scholarships to graduating high school seniors annually
- Our club volunteers to ring the bell for the Salvation Army during the holidays
- We work with the United Way on various projects during the year
- Each September, our club partners with Wayne Community College to produce a Field of Honor®. This event allows the community to support our projects by purchasing an American flag that is displayed in honor of fallen heroes, first responders, active-duty and retired military personnel, teachers, and neighbors. The event runs for about two months on the campus of Wayne Community College.
- Our mini-grant program awards grants to local groups to support their missions.

- Our club supports our District Governor's Global Project each year and collaborate with our sister club, Three Eagles Rotary, in their projects.
